


This is my library: The La Grange Park Public Library.




When I enter the library, I walk and use my quiet voice.

This is the Children's Department. I can ask a librarian if I need help with anything.




I can look for books, movies, and toys.




I can look for a specific title in the catalog. It tells me where the item is located.

Read.




Use the computer or iPad to look up information, play games, or do my homework.

Color a picture or do an activity.




Write on the board.
