I can look for a specific title in the catalog. It tells me where the item is located.



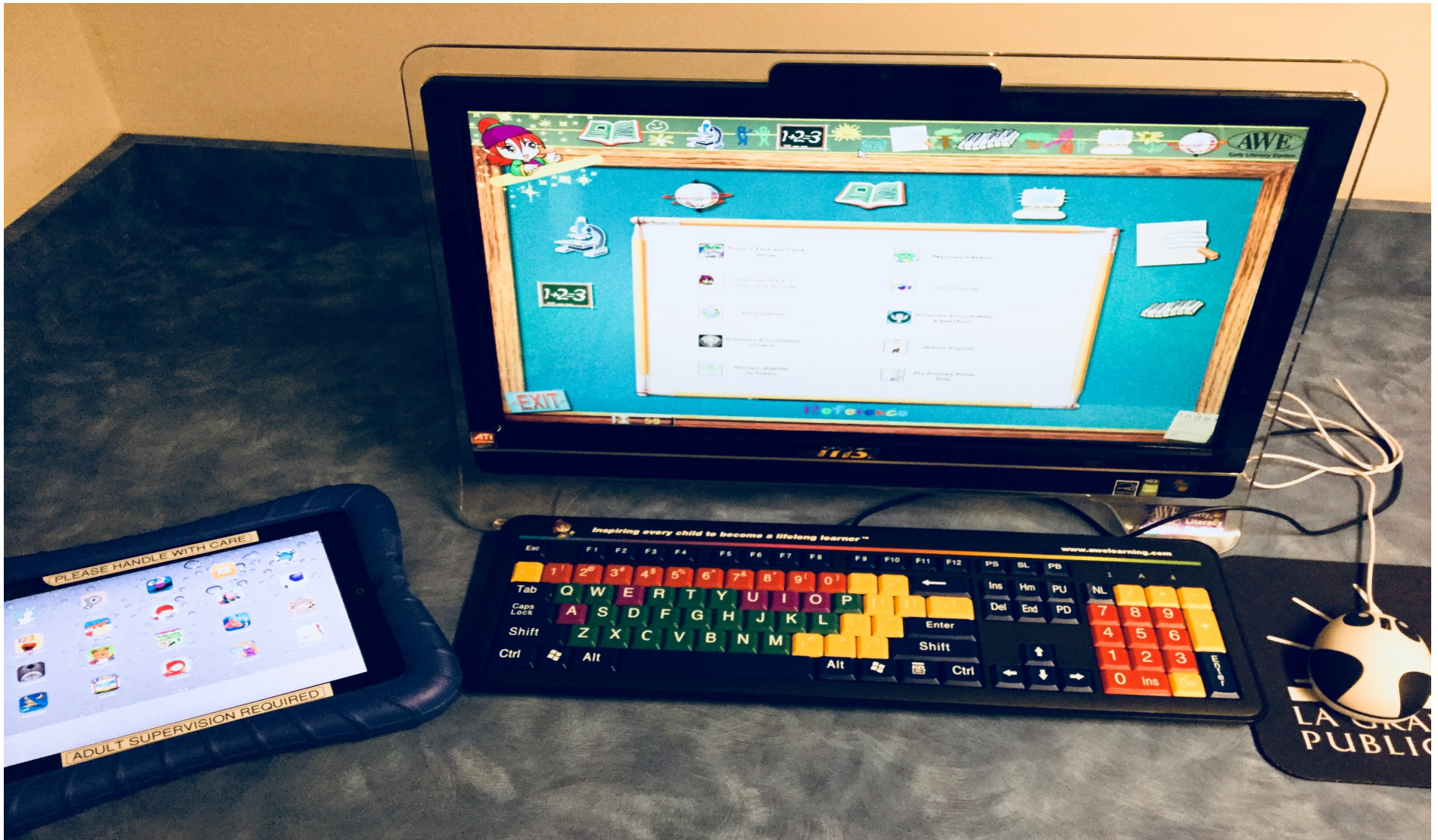
There are lots of other things to do at the library.

I can...



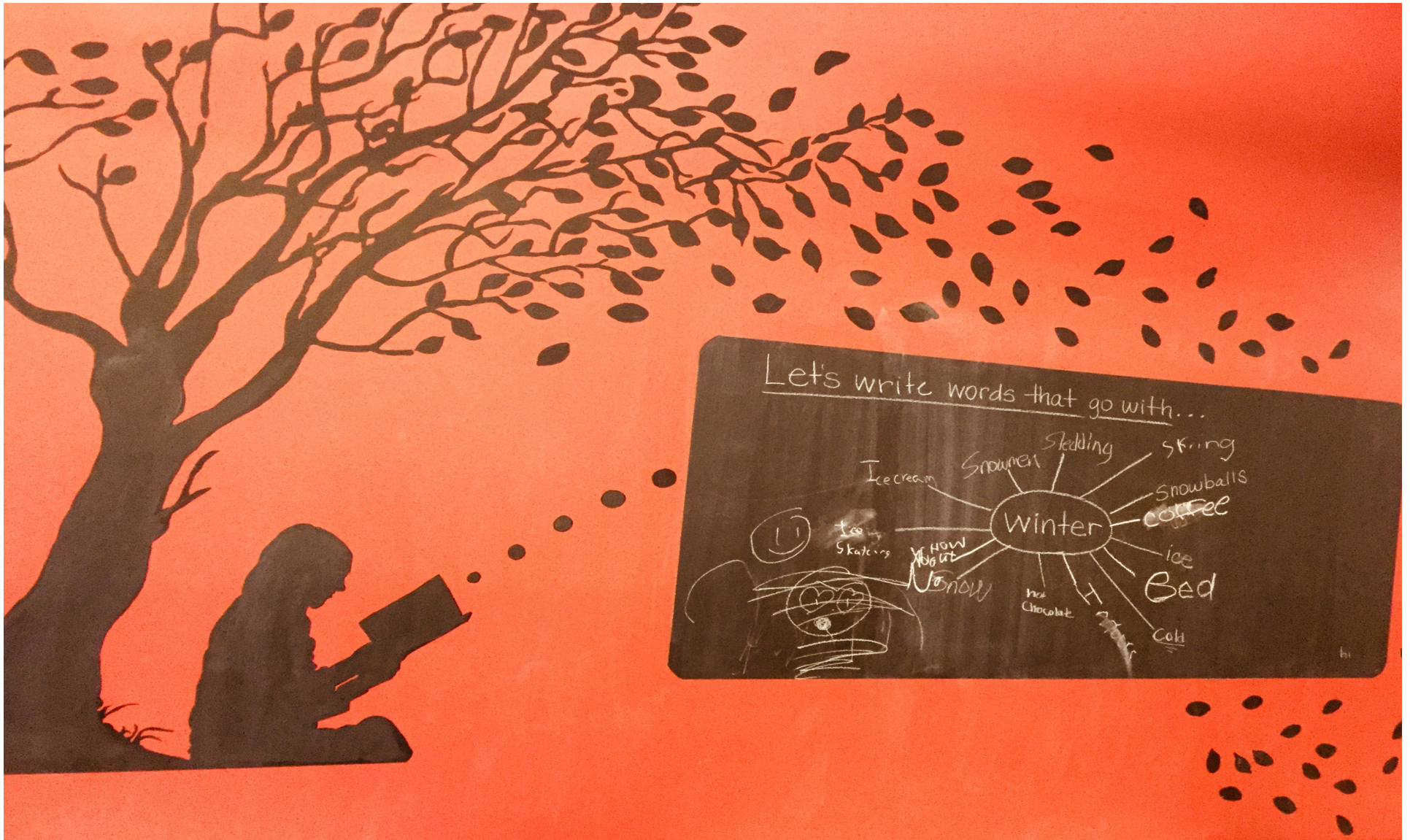
Put on a puppet show.
