About Us

Established in 1975, the La Grange Park Public Library is a welcoming and inclusive community center connecting residents to informational, cultural, and educational resources.

About Us

The current 21,000 square foot facility was erected in 1989. It underwent a remodel of the third floor in 2004. It has been largely untouched since that time.

Known Problems

Since 2014, the library board has investigated various facility-related issues:

- <u>Structural Damage:</u> east wall, west wall, clerestory
- Ongoing Maintenance: capital costs will amount to approximately \$200,000/yr moving forward
- Service Concerns: library use has changed since 1989 and LPPL must evolve with it

Structural Damage

Joint failures and lack of insulation have caused water infiltration, rust, and deterioration, along primarily the east wall.



Columns have condensation issues due to improper insulation and installation. Significant rust has already formed on columns on the east and west walls.


Structural Damage

- Project cost: \$1.5 \$2.5 million (based on 2015 cost estimates)
- Project timeline ranging from 7-10 months
- The only option for repair is a rebuild & proper insulation process. There are no stop-gap measures that will suffice.

Library use has changed in the last 10 years.


It has changed dramatically since the library was built.

A New Model For Public Libraries:


The Pew Research data led us to propose a new planning model for public libraries in which housing and supporting the traditional library collection is no longer the primary focus of library design but rather one of several equally important components. This approach places equal importance on what goes on within the library as with what is contained within the library.

Our new library model is a vehicle for providing services that are described by 3 verbs; "Consume/Connect/Create."








The total cost to damage is in the neighborhood of

2.2 million dollars, c. a minute vienna, as of estimates given in 2015. Considering inflation, we estimate dose to 2.5 million in total costs with a timeline of 7-10 months for completion. There is not a temporary or less costly fix. The damage is such that we need a complete rebuild. We have been osked if the library will need to dose for these renovations, and that answer is difficult to give at this point. It is our goal to avoid doores and keep the library open as much as possible during construction within the constraints of public safety.

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Maintenance Issues
